**Copy of Notification: Notice to revoke a Hazardous Classification at LLANWERN
WORKS EAST LANDFILL SITE- EAWML Ref No. 30003 from 16 July 2004**

Please find attached a copy of a notice sent to the licence holder of the above landfill site revoking the hazardous classification at the site.

From the 16 July 2004 the site will only be able to accept non-hazardous/inert waste. If a separate cell is available for stable non-reactive hazardous waste (and meets the requirements of the WML together with LFD RGN 11, "The disposal in landfills for non-hazardous waste of stable, non-reactive hazardous and asbestos wastes as well as wastes with a high sulphate or gypsum content") then such waste may be accepted.

There will be no need to modify the waste management licence for this site as continued disposal of hazardous waste in a non-hazardous landfill (assuming this is allowed under the existing WML) will be in direct contravention of Regulation 10(2) as applied by Schedule 4 paragraph 3(3)(b) of the Landfill (England and Wales) Regulations 2002.

Copies of this letter will be sent to the public register for the PPC application for the site.

**The Pollution Prevention And Control (England And Wales) Regulations 2000 (SI 2000 No 1973), as amended, (the PPC Regulations);
The Landfill (England and Wales) Regulations 2002 (SI 2002 No 1559) as amended**

Notification that from 16 July 2004 your classification as a Hazardous Waste Landfill at Llanwern Works East Landfill Site – Ref No. 30003 has been revoked

I am writing to you as the holder of a waste management licence for a landfill site currently classified as hazardous but which you have identified will revert to a non-hazardous classification after the 16 July 2004.

Please find attached a notice issued in accordance with Schedule 4, paragraph 3(2) of the Landfill (England and Wales) Regulations 2002 revoking the classification as hazardous from 16 July 2004.

From the 16 July 2004 the site will no longer be able to accept hazardous waste, other than stable non-reactive hazardous waste (SNRHW) deposited within a separate cell that meets the requirements of the WML/Permit and RGN 11.

Revocation of the hazardous waste classification means that the site now becomes non-hazardous or inert. Receipt of hazardous waste (other than SNRHW) after 16 July 2004 will be an offence under Regulation 10(2) of the Landfill regulations (as applied by schedule 4 of paragraph (3) (3) (6)).

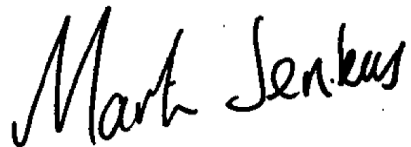
Please note there is no need to modify the WML to give effect to these proposals which apply directly from the Landfill Regulations on 16 July 2004 provided the hazardous classification has been revoked.

Please find enclosed a statement of the Agency's approach to compliance and enforcement. You may wish to copy this to your customers to help raise awareness.
