Schedule B- TYPES OF WASTE

B1. Types of waste materials accepted at the facility and the maximum quantities accepted per day shall consist only of the following solid wastes.

Waste Type	Quantity
Household and commercial waste	450 tonnes
Industrial Wastes	450 tonnes

B2. Only the following categories of difficult waste, as defined under Appendix 7c of Waste Management Paper No 26 (1986) Edition, shall be accepted at the site:

Waste Type	Category	Quantity
Street sweeping and gulley emptying wastes	R20	50 tonnes per day
Animal carcasses	Tf1	1 tonne per day

B3. The following special wastes, as defined under the Special Waste Regulations 1996, shall be accepted at the civic amenity area for storage only:

Waste Type	Maximum Quantity Stored
Waste engine oil from motor vehicles	600 gallons
Lead acid motor vehicle batteries	50 No.
Bonded Asbestos Cement Products	1x 8 cubic yard skip

B4. No special waste shall be disposed of at the site.

Exclusions

B5. Notwithstanding the generality of the types of waste specified in this Schedule the following wastes shall be specifically excluded from delivery to the facility without the prior written approval of the Environment Agency.

- a/ Difficult wastes other than those detailed in condition B2.
- b/ Special waste other than those detailed in condition B3.

c/ Substances within the control of the Radioactive Substances Act 1993 and subsequent amendments.

d/ Percussives and explosives and other substances with similar characteristics, excepting where such waste are in such a form or state where the percussive or explosive properties are and will remain ineffective;

e/ Any waste containing substances listed in the Highly Flammable Liquids and Liquefied Petroleum Gases Regulations 1972.

f/ Drummed waste or liquid wastes (other than road sweeping/gulley emptying wastes for disposal and waste engine oil and lead acid motor vehicle batteries delivered to the civic amenity area for subsequent recycling).
