1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background

- 1.1.1 Caulmert Limited were appointed to prepare an application to transfer the environmental permit for the waste operation of Brecon Transfer Station Llanwern, Brecon, Powys, and Wales (hereinafter called 'the site')
- 1.1.2 The permit number for the permit being transferred is ERP Ref: CB3834RQ
- 1.1.3 It is planned that Powys County Council will take over the operation of the Site on 27th February 2017.

1.2 Document structure

2.3.1 The site will be managed in line with an Environmental Management System (EMS).


2.3.2 A new management system will be introduced which is a bespoke system for the site that will compliment Powys County Councils accredited ISO 14001 Management System
