- 1.2.1 No wastes other than those, which are categorised below in Table 1.2A, section 2.2.4 of the working plan and specified in detail in Appendix A to these conditions, shall be accepted at the site.

- e** date removed;
- f** quantities in tonnes removed and waste type;
- g** destination of waste removed;
- nature of the waste (solid, liquid or sludge.)

Summary records of wastes accepted and removed

7.2.2

A summary record of the waste types and quantities accepted and removed from the site shall be made for each quarter of the financial year and shall be submitted to the Agency within 1 month following the end of that quarter. The summary record shall be in the format detailed in Appendix B or otherwise subsequently agreed with the Agency in writing.
