

The Application

Introduction

ABP is using land at Roath Dock Cardiff, to store up to 3,000 tonnes of processed wood waste and 5,000 tonnes of baled refuse derived fuel prior to export for energy recovery.

ABP is in full control of the operation and will use ABP operatives to manage the waste and load vessels for export.

Material will only be stored on the dock to fulfil specific customer orders. Supplier contracts will ensure that material is only kept on the dockside for a limited period and generally for no longer than 3 months.

Site Description

The location of the site is within Roath Dock. It is a typical port area within a secure operational dock. It has a sealed surface, with surface water drainage.

OPERATIONAL CONTROLS

ABP will operate to this Environmental Management System and has produced its own operational procedures for this biomass and RDF export facility.

Technically Competent Person

Overall responsibility for the safe, efficient and effective operation of the site sits with **Craig Christoforato**.

Mark Robson will provide technically competent supervision having obtained a WAMITAB certificate in Non hazardous transfer/with or without treatment (Certificate OCC65682).

The Operations Manager will be responsible for ensuring that all day-to-day compliance requirements are met, especially regarding:

- Waste acceptance and control procedures
- Operational controls
- Maintenance
- Record-keeping
- Emergency action plans & coordination of ship loading.
- Recording and reporting of any incidents, complainants or emergencies.

Site Security

The site has a fully manned security gate and security officers are present. The site is under 24 hour CCTV surveillance.

Site Identification Board

On granting of a permit an identification board will be displayed for site users at the site entrance. In the interim a notice board will be erected identifying the operator and giving contact numbers in the event of an incident, complaint or emergency. Contact details will also be provided to the Fire and Rescue Service
